

## How can green cleaning earn LEED Points?

The LEED-EB Rating certification is based on a point system, with at least 31 points needed for certification. Green cleaning practices can help you earn points in the following categories.

<b>Green Cleaning: Isolation of Janitorial Closets</b>	<b>1 point</b>
<b>Green Cleaning: Low Environmental Impact Cleaning Policy</b>	<b>1 point</b>
<b>Green Cleaning: Low Environmental Impact Pest Management Policy</b>	<b>2 points</b>
